

Idaho Background Check Information for Peer Providers

Passing a background check will most likely be a condition of employment as a certified peer support specialist in Idaho. We encourage you to be aware of your ability to pass a background check prior to applying to Peer Support Training; however, you are not required to submit your background check with your training application. Your background check will be conducted by your future employer.

Please note that you may not be able to pass a background check if you have had a felony in the last 5 years even if it is not a disqualifying offense.

Background Check Waivers

The Idaho Department of Health and Welfare also has a Background Check Waiver Application for individuals who receive a denial from the Background Check Unit. The Background Check Waiver is an opportunity to have that denial waived in order to work as a certified peer support specialist.
